BEN BENNETT

HEAD COACH

Ben Bennett enters his first season with the Austin Wranglers as head coach and his sixth season as an af2 head coach overall. Before joining the Wranglers, Bennett spent the last three years with the Manchester Wolves (2005-07). Prior to his time with Manchester, he was the head coach of the Florida Firecats from 2003-04. In five seasons as an af2 head coach, Bennett has compiled a 56-33 record and currently ranks third overall in league history in career coaching victories. Bennett-coached teams have never had fewer than ten wins in a season, and all five of his teams have made it to the playoffs. Bennett's 2004 Florida Firecats squad won the ArenaCup. Another notable season for Bennett was in 2005 when he turned around a 5-11 Wolves team and took them to the playoffs following a 12-4 regular season and East Division title. During his playing days, Bennett enjoyed a 10-year AFL career as a quarterback where he made five ArenaBowl appearances and was named to the All-Arena First Team on three separate occasions. At the conclusion of his playing career, which saw him amass 14,168 yards passed and 267 touchdowns, Bennett was inducted into the AFL Hall-of-Fame in 2000. He attended Duke University where, as a freshman quarterback, he was voted Atlantic Coast Conference Rookie of the Year. His best individual game as a collegian came against Wake Forest where he set three NCAA freshman records by completing 38-of-62 passes for 469 yards. After four successful seasons, Bennett completed his collegiate career as the top passer in the history of NCAA Division I-A football with the most passes attempted (1,375), the most passes completed (820), and the most passing yardage (9,614).

JON NORRIS

HEAD COACH

In 2007 Jon Norris guided the BattleWings to an 11-5 regular season record and the first playoff berth in team history. A true pioneer of Arena Football Norris was a player for the inaugural season champion Denver Dynamite in 1987. Norris has great credibility within the Arena Football community with his 14 years of experience as a player and coach in both the AFL and af2. He came to the BattleWings from the Austin Wranglers of the AFL where he served as the Defensive Coordinator and Line Coach. He made a demonstrative difference in Austin where in 2005, the offensive line gave up only 4 sacks which led the AFL.

Prior to the Wranglers, Norris spent 3 seasons with the Dallas Desperados in the AFL where he served as line coach and special teams coach. His line racked up some impressive stats and in 2003 Norris coached AFL Lineman of the Year Tom Briggs. Norris moved to Dallas after a stint as assistant head coach and offensive and defensive line coach for the Oklahoma Wranglers. Prior to Oklahoma, Norris served as head coach for the Tulsa Talons and led them to the af2 playoffs in their inaugural season with an offense that averaged 52.7 points per game and a defense that led the league with 33 interceptions.

Coach Norris was born in Wales, United Kingdom, he received his Bachelor's degree from America International College and a Master's degree from Adams State. He spent time in the NFL with the New England Patriots in 1985.
