GAME STORY FROM LAST GAME:

The Bossier-Shreveport BattleWings claimed their first division championship in team history on Saturday night with a 65-54 victory over Southwest Division rivals Austin Wranglers. The BattleWings opened the 1st quarter with four straight touchdown drives, after allowing a 33 yard touchdown strike from Wrangler QB Andy Hall to WR Sean Henley, and scored on their first eight offensive possessions of the game. WR Chavis McCollister led the Wings' early offensive charge with a 57 yard kickoff return for a touchdown, 2 touchdown rushes from 2 and 4 yards out, and 2 touchdown receptions spanning 13 and 31 yards to stake the BattleWings to a 49-27 halftime lead.

The Wings' first half fury was reduced to a fizzle as the Wranglers limited the BattleWings to only 16 points in the second half. The Wranglers cut

their 22 point halftime deficit to 5 with 4:51 remaining in the game on a WR John Roberson 26 yard touchdown catch. The BattleWings, backed up at their own 3 yard line, answered with a 7 play, 47 yard drive finished by FB Jason Schule's 3 yard touchdown run.

RODNEY BLACKSHEAR



HEAD COACH

The 2007 season was not only the inaugural season for the Renegades, but it was the af2 head coaching debut for Rodney Blackshear. The Renegades finished the 2007 season with a 7-9 record and in third place of the National Conference's Southwest Division. The 7-9 finish was tied for the third best finish of the ten inaugural teams in the af2 last season.

Blackshear came to the Renegades as no stranger to arena football and had previously coached in the af2. He spent the 2004 season as the Offensive Coordinator/Director of Player Personnel for the af2's Rio Grande Valley Dorados in Hidalgo, Texas. Following the 2004 season, Blackshear joined the University of Houston's coaching staff as the receiver's coach.

A native of Houston, Blackshear played four years at Texas Tech University from 1987-1991, before embarking on a career in the Arena Football League (AFL), where he played in 60 games spanning five seasons. Blackshear combined for 204 receptions for 2,482 yards and 45 receiving touchdowns in 52 games in Houston. He also recorded a touchdown off an interception and off a missed field-goal attempt. The 1998 All-Arena First Team (WR/DB) honoree closed out his AFL career with the 2001 Arena Bowl Champion Grand Rapids Rampage. The former Red Raider was a member of Spike Dykes' inaugural recruiting class. Blackshear led the Red Raiders in receiving in 1990 (44 rec., 973 yds, 9 TDs) and 1991 (30 rec., 649 yds, 5 TDs). He ranks third at Tech with 973 single-season yards in 1990 and also is tied for third at Tech with nine single-season TD receptions in 1990 (junior season). Overall, he ranks fourth in career yardage (1,980) and is tied for third with 14 career receiving touchdowns on Tech's all-time list. Blackshear holds the Southwest Conference (SWC) and Texas Tech single-game record with 251 against Houston (five receptions- 50.2

avg.) in 1991. He left Tech holding Tech's all-time record for career yards per reception with 20.4 and was awarded the Red Raiders "Team MVP" honor in 1990 and "Team Leadership" honor in 1991. Blackshear was honored as a two-time All-SWC member from 90-91, and received invitations to the Blue-Gray Game and the Japan Bowl in 1991.

One of his biggest accomplishments was becoming the first ever player to return a kickoff for a touchdown against the legendary 12th Man kickoff unit of Texas A&M, which led to A&M discontinuing the tradition the following season. Blackshear also spent one season as a student assistant at Texas Tech in 2002. He spent the 2003 season as the offensive coordinator at Harvest Christian High School in Fort Worth. In 2005, Blackshear joined the staff of the Rio Grande Valley Dorados as the Offensive Coordinator. Blackshear earned his Bachelor's degree in telecommunications from Tech in 2003.

JON NORRIS

HEAD COACH



Jon Norris leads the BattleWings back to the playoffs in 2008 after guiding the BattleWings to an 11-5 regular season record and the first playoff berth in team history in 2007. A true pioneer of Arena Football, Norris was a player for the inaugural season champion Denver Dynamite in 1987. Norris has great credibility within the Arena Football community with his 14 years of experience as a player and coach in both the AFL and af2. He came to the BattleWings from the Austin Wranglers of the AFL where he served as the Defensive Coordinator and Line Coach. He made a demonstrative difference in Austin where in 2005, the offensive line gave up only 4 sacks which led the AFL.

Prior to the Wranglers, Norris spent 3 seasons with the Dallas Desperados in the AFL where he served as line coach and special teams coach. His line racked up some impressive stats and in 2003 Norris coached AFL Lineman of the Year Tom Briggs. Norris moved to Dallas after a stint as assistant head coach and offensive and defensive line coach for the Oklahoma Wranglers. Prior to Oklahoma, Norris served as head coach for the Tulsa Talons and led them to the af2 playoffs in their inaugural season with an offense that averaged 52.7 points per game and a defense that led the league with 33 interceptions.

Coach Norris was born in Wales, United Kingdom, he received his Bachelor's degree from America International College and a Master's degree from Adams State. He spent time in the NFL with the New England Patriots in 1985. 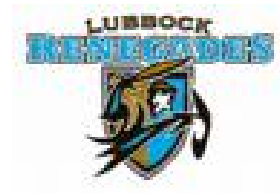
